Organization Information

State Law: By law of the State of Texas, the County of Orange collects a Hotel Occupancy Tax (HOT) from hotels, motels, and bed & breakfasts and inns. Under state law, the revenue from the HOT may be used only to directly promote tourism and the convention and hotel industry. The use of HOT funds is limited to eligibility requirements set forth in Chapter 352 of the Tax Code.

HOT FUNDS WILL BE DISTIRBUTED TO APPROVED APPLICANTS <u>AFTER</u> THE EVENT HAS OCCURRED, ALL SUPPLEMENTAL DOCUMENTATION HAS BEEN RECEIVED AND THE REQUEST IS DETERMINED TO HAVE MET THE QUALIFICATIONS OF THE PROGRAM.

2025-2026 APPLICATIONS ACCEPTED AUGUST 1, 2025 THROUGH AUGUST 31, 2025 APPLIED FUNDS MUST BE FOR ACTIVITIES OCCURING OCTOBER 1, 2025 THROUGH SEPTEMBER 30, 2026. APPLICATIONS WILL BE REVIEWED IN OCTOBER OF EACH YEAR BUT CAN BE SUBMITTED AT ANY TIME FOR SPECIAL REVIEW SHOULD FUNDS BE AVAILABLE.
